Summary

Dr. Suresh Jungari is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Public Health & Mortality Studies at the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), Mumbai. He holds a Master's and Ph.D. in Population Studies from IIPS and brings over a decade of teaching and research experience, specializing in public health, maternal and tribal health, gender issues in reproductive health, health inequities, and occupational health. He has been involved in several major projects funded by national and international organizations. Dr. Jungari is Co-PI of "Longitudinal Ageing Study in India (LASI) Wave-2". Dr. Jungari work integrates rigorous empirical analysis of large-scale datasets such as the National Family Health Surveys (NFHS) and Census data with field-based research, particularly among tribal and rural communities in Maharashtra. In recent years, he has also expanded his research to include occupational health, with a focus on the health challenges faced by informal and marginalized workers in India, an area critical to understanding broader public health disparities in India. With decade of teaching experience, Dr. Jungari plays a vital role in shaping academic discourse across a wide range of subjects including population and health, occupational and maternal health, reproductive health, mortality studies, historical demography, and the social determinants of health. He is actively engaged in mentoring Ph.D. scholars and has authored more than 50 research articles published in high-impact national and international peer-reviewed journals. His current research explores the complexities of maternal mental health a critically important but underexplored domain, while also contributing to the emerging scholarship on occupational health in India. Through his academic and field-based work, Dr. Jungari continues to influence evidence-based public health policies and interventions aimed at reducing health disparities and promoting equitable access to healthcare.
