ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS) Mumbai, formerly known as the Demographic Training and Research, Centre (DTRC) till 1970, was established in July 1956 under the joint sponsorship of Sir Dorabji Tata Trust, the Government of India, and the United Nations. The Institute serves as a regional centre for Training and Research in Population Studies for the The Institute was re-ESCAP region. designated to its present title in 1985 to facilitate the expansion of its academic activities and was declared as a 'Deemed University' on August 14, 1985, under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The recognition has facilitated the award of recognized degrees by the Institute itself and paved the way for further expansion of the Institute as an academic Institution. The faculty members and the supporting staff belong to a diverse interdisciplinary background with specialization in core areas of population sciences, trained in India and abroad.

The Institute is the hub of population and health related teaching and research in India, playing a vital role for planning and development of the country. During the past years, students from different countries of Asia and the Pacific region, Africa and North America have been trained at the Institute. The alumni of the Institute are occupying prestigious positions in reputed national and international organizations, universities, research Institutes, and nongovernmental organizations.

The Institute offers various different Post-Graduate, Doctoral, and the Post-Doctoral courses. After completing the course, students of all programmes will be prepared for; (i) admission to higher degree programmes in the best universities of the world; (ii) a good career in teaching and research; (iii) a multi-disciplinary professional career; or (iv) working as Independent consultant and specialist in health and development sectors.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

01. Two years - Master of Arts/Science in Population Studies (MA/MSc)

Applications are invited from International students for admission to MA/MSc in Population studies for the Academic Session 2024-2025. The classes for the course will commence from August 2024.

ABOUT THIS COURSE:

This course provides rigorous training in Population Studies and its interrelationship with other related disciplines. The two-years course curriculum comprises of demographic theory and methods, gender and reproductive health, research methodology, statistics demographic and statistical software, and data analysis. This course equips students with necessary skills to understand and analysis the different components of population change to understand the consequences of population change, to track the population changes for understanding the future population, interrelationship between population, development and health, gender issues in the population, etc.

DURATION: Two years (Full-Time)

ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates with a Bachelor's degree from a recognized university [established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess. Accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution] in any subject with a minimum of 55 percentage or equivalent grade in any subject, shall be eligible to apply.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Admission shall be offered to those students who fulfil the eligibility criteria and able to secure two recommendation letters from academic working in the area of Population Studies. As the medium of instruction is English, the candidates applying for DUN admission to this course should be able to demonstrate their fluency in working in English.

COURSE FEES:

The total fee for this course is USD 2000 in a year. Students from SAARC countries are eligible for 50% waiver of the proposed fees.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Institute have limited accommodation for International students in the Campus.

02. Two - years Master of Science in Biostatistics and Demography (MBD)

Applications are invited from International students for admission to Master of Science in Bio-Statistics and Demography (MBD) during the academic session 2024-25. The classes for the course will commence from August 2024.

ABOUT THIS COURSE:

This course provides rigorous training in Population Studies and its interrelationship with other related disciplines. The two-year course curriculum comprises of demographic theory and methods, gender reproductive health, research and methodology, statistics demographic and statistical software, and data analysis. This course equips students with necessary skills to understand and analyze the different components of population change to understand the consequences of population change, to track the population changes for understanding the future population, interrelationship between population, development and health, gender issues in the population, etc.

DURATION: Two years (Full-Time)

ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates with a Bachelor's degree from a recognized university in Bio-statistics or Health Statistics or Mathematics or Statistics or having B.A./B.Sc. degree with two full papers on Mathematics or Statistics from a recognized university [established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess. Accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution] with a minimum of 55 percentage or equivalent grade in any subject, shall be eligible to apply..

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Admission shall be offered to those students who fulfil the eligibility criteria and able to secure two recommendation letters from academic working in the area of Population Studies. As the medium of instruction is English, the candidates applying for admission to this course should be able to demonstrate their fluency in working in English.

COURSE FEES:

The total fee for this course is USD 2000 in a year. Students from SAARC countries are eligible for 50% waiver of the proposed fees.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Institute has limited accommodation for International students in Campus.

03. Four-year Doctor of Philosophy in Population Studies (Ph.D.)

Applications are invited from International students for admission to Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) in Population Studies during the academic session 2024-25. The classes for the course will commence from August 2024.

DURATION: Four years (Full-Time)

ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates having a)1-Year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4 semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body [established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess. Accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution] with at least 55 percentage marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75 percentage marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed.

OR

A Candidate who have competed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55 percentage marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed, shall be eligible to apply.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Admission shall be offered to those students who fulfil the above eligibility criteria and the submit the following documents: -

- a) The medium of instructions in Master's degree must be in 'ENGLISH'.
- b) A writing sample that demonstrates candidate's writing and analytical

skills. This can be published article or draft paper.

- c) A research proposal of not more than 2000 words.
- d) A recommendation letter.

COURSE FEES:

The total fee for this course is USD 3000 in a year. Students from SAARC countries are eligible for 50% waiver of the proposed fees.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Institute has limited accommodation for international students in the Campus.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The Institute shall provide all necessary assistance to the international students for securing financial support from various national and International organizations.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS CELL

The Institute has a fully functional International Relations Cell (IRC) that facilitates the International students in securing Indian visa, finding, shared/PG accommodation in the neighborhood, completing other formalities and addressing any pressing issue that requires Institute's intervention.
