Since its inception in 1956, IIPS has been at the forefront of conducting training programs in Population Studies for trainees from various countries in Asia and the Pacific region. The teaching program of the Institute has expanded significantly in the last one decade. Currently, IIPS offers three master's degree programs in the regular mode and another through distance mode. The Ph.D program of IIPS has been unique with a strong emphasis on research methods with empirical enquiry. 
